Inscription fares: US\$ 100 for SFI or SAI Non-members, US\$ 60 for SFI or SAI Members, US\$ 50 for Students, resident and Fellows.

This will include registration to the congress, lunch, coffee breaks and a CD of the course.

Travel grants available: The SAI will grant a number of travel awards to assist young investigators to attend the course. To be eligible for an award, an individual must be a trainee and as such must be within three (3) years completion of their training and/or fellowship and that present an abstract in the 1st French – Argentinean joint meeting to be held in Buenos Aires (3-5 November 2010). Awardees will be selected from the pool of eligible applicants based upon the abstract's degree of excellence as determined by the Joint Planning Committee. To apply for these awards, a supporting letter must be sent along with the abstract to be submitted to the Congress. This letter must be signed by the applicant's Training Program Director verifying that the award applicant is indeed a young investigator. The award applicant MUST be the presenting author of the abstract and no exceptions will be made.
