

## THE HELLENIC PASTEUR INSTITUTE IS ANNOUNCING THE EMPLOYMENT POSITION OF GENERAL DIRECTOR

The Hellenic Pasteur Institute invites applications for the position of General Director, according to the provisions of the bilateral agreement between the Greek Government and the Institut Pasteur in Paris (Law 3733/2009) and the general legislative framework in force on Research and Technology.

Candidates must be internationally accredited scientists, qualify for the position of Researcher Grade A and have management experience and previous employment in services organisation and management. Adequate knowledge of the Greek language shall be an additional asset and will be taken into consideration along with other qualifications of each candidate.

Candidate applications must be accompanied by a detailed CV providing proof of relevance of research activities to one of the scientific subjects/areas of the Institute and compatibility with the scientific virtues and goals of the Hellenic Pasteur Institute.

Candidates will be classified, among others, based on their experience in the sections of activation of the Hellenic Pasteur Institute, their overall scientific activity, their administrative and managerial abilities and their administrative experience in the section of Public Health.

Candidates should have experience in the following areas:

- A. Public Health Policy and Management
- B. Fundamental and/ or Applied Research in a scientific field of Biomedical Research

The term is for five (5) years and subject to renewal. The position is full time and the employment contract is governed by Greek Law.

The successful candidate will have the opportunity to develop research activities within the scope of the Institute's research activities.

The General Director manages the Institute, directs its services and is responsible for the composition of the research and development programme.
